★IET – Engagement	Engagement of substance use treatment —2 services within 34 days of initiating treatment	\$100 per compliant visit, no target to meet
★FUH – 7	Follow-up After Mental Health Hospitalization – 7 days total	\$50 per compliant visit, no target to meet

The IET measure evaluates the percentage of patients 13 years of age and older with a new episode of substance use disorder that resulted in treatment initiation and engagement.	ICD-10 diagnosis for Alcohol or Other Drug Dependence from the Mental, Behavioral and Neurodevelopmental Disorder Section must be included along with the procedure code.
